## T.A. Stewart Memorial Award

Bill has been a keen exhibitor and has won every championship of the Society as well as the Australian Rose Championship. He has turned his hand to the hybridizing of roses and has several roses now on the market. These include 'Alice', 'Rednella', 'Peter Benjamin', 'Karen Julie'.

Bill has attended all the meetings of the National Rose Society of Australia and was a delegate on two occasions. He and his wife Alice have always been active in any of the trips and social activities arranged by the Rose Society of Victoria and he has done all that he could to promote the rose.
