You could walk 650m to the corner of South Terrace and Labouchere Road to catch the bus to the Zoo. **Zoo is open from 9am - 5pm**. **Entry cost: Adult \$34.60, Concession \$27.50.** Make the most of your time at the Zoo and check out their many activities at: **https://perthzoo.wa.gov.au/**.

You can book a 1 hour guided tour in the Zebra Cars (golf buggy - 7 passengers), 9.30am - 2.00pm. The car goes on the main road loop and you can alight at the stops. **Cost: Adult \$5, Concession \$4.**
